Tuzla Cantonal Chamber of Commerce/Centre for Regional Cooperation in cooperation with the Faculty of Technology University of Tuzla, organized an official presentation and launch of the project "Creation of cooperation between universities and industry in the area of sustainable technologies". The meeting of the Chamber was devoted to analysis and review of existing knowledge the staff from industry on sustainable technologies issues. The 3 years lasting project included partners from universities, enterprises and chambers of commerce's. The university partners are from Germany, Belgium, Austria, Serbia, The Former Yugoslav Republic Macedonia and Bosnia and Hercegovina. The delegation from Tuzla university, with guest from Belgium and Germany, had a meeting with Nedret Kikanović, director of the Tuzla Cantonal Chambers of Commerce and associates. The partners are at the beginning of an important project in which the Chamber and the

university partners are intend to promote cooperation with industry on sustainable technologies issue. To the EU guests the industry of the Tuzla Canton was presented in relation to sustainable technologies. The cooperation of the Chamber of commerce and the University is important for the development and improvement of the economy and must be related to science. If we do not use the scientific resources of the University, we can't expect greater development in the future, said the director Kikanovic. Director of the Chamber of commerce presented the basic indicators of economic trends in the Tuzla Canton, with emphasis on the decline in production volume, reducing investment, declining exports and increasing unemployment. Nurudin Zunic Secretary of Industry, Energy and Mining Tuzla Cantonal Chambers of Commerce, presented the major environmental problems in the Canton, Canton geographical position and the position of the mining industry. Particularly he mentioned the problem of pollution of air and water in our Canton. Secretary of the chemistry and non-metals, spoke on cleaner production in industry through the Project is "Capacity building for implementation of cleaner production in industry, TK", including the sustainable development and environmental protection. Chamber of commerce in this project plays an important role, said Midhat Jašić, local coordinator. Marc Van Acker, from Ghent, Belgium said that connecting experience with the practice is the main objective of the project. The intention is to start training for the staff from industry. The most important segment is the transfer of knowledge related to the EU regulations related to the environment.
